

Fourth Day and Reunion Group Notes from the Board

As we approach the B.V.E.C. milestones represented by the upcoming Walks 100 and 101, let us all remember, especially Sponsors, that our responsibility to the new Pilgrims does not end at the closing ceremony on Sunday or when they are delivered home to their loved ones, the Fourth Day still remains as an integral part of the Walk's experience. It is a Pilgrim's day of Pentecost where he/she, like the Disciples so long ago, proclaim their service to the Lord.

Some might ask, "Why, if a Pilgrim willingly gives witness to his/her Walk experience at the closing ceremony on Sunday, is it necessary to do this yet again?" Well there are several reasons. First of all they have had some time to digest what happened at the Walk. They almost certainly have discussed the experience with friends and loved ones. Time will have passed and they are no longer quite as close to the emotions felt during and immediately after the Walk. The days leading to the Fourth Day provides an opportunity to remold their perspective and recommit themselves to the Lord's service. After all, if they know that this Fourth Day opportunity must still be faced, would they not dwell on the subject in preparation? It's a way of encouraging a Pilgrim to think about the reality of picking up the mantel of a disciple.

This is the first opportunity a new Pilgrim has to meet, dine and worship with the open Community. Here they will make friends who will stand by them for the rest of their lives. They will hopefully discover how rewarding it is to remain close to the Community and to stay engaged in its mission. They will also find a lot of new recipes.

Finally, Walk history suggests that new Pilgrims who do not attend their Fourth Day are less likely to remain active in Community affairs.
