2 Hill Top Lakes Drive, Hilltop Lakes, TX 77871

From Bryan: take Hwy. 21 East toward Madisonville 22.4-miles, at North Zulch turn left on FM 39 go North 7.8-miles to Normangee, turn left on FM 3, go 8-miles Hilltop Lakes is on the right. Turn right on Hilltop Drive and the Chapel is about 1/4 mile on the right. The Fellowship Hall is the first building on the right.

From Hearne/Franklin: go North on Hwy. 79 through Franklin 18.2-miles, turn right on FM 3, go 10.7-miles turn left on Hilltop Drive, the Chapel is on the right.

From IH-45: exit 152 on OSR, go West on OSR 10.1-miles to Normangee, turn right on FM 39, then turn left at the next intersection on FM 3 for 8-miles, turn right on Hilltop Drive, the Chapel is on the right.

From Buffalo and IH-45: go Southwest on Hwy 79 21.2-miles, turn left on FM 3 10.7 miles, turn left on Hilltop Drive, the Chapel is on the right.

We will start by enjoying fantastic company at 5 PM, then worship together at 6 PM.
